Keep caring and sharing - Specific needs

Provide urgent support for specific needs regularly communicated by our non-profit network members.

Examples of needs:

- solid shelves to store a food stock corner or laundry baskets for each resident
- a professional color and network photocopier
- USB keys
- purchase of a low-cost car to drive residents to medical appointments
- second-hand laptops
- a rounded mirror to make traffic safer in the educational farm
- a miter saw
- a display fridge
- sports equipment (ex: gym equipment, fitness, football, shirts) for the refugees...

It is our duty to make **the world a better place** and if I can do something to make it happen, I will!

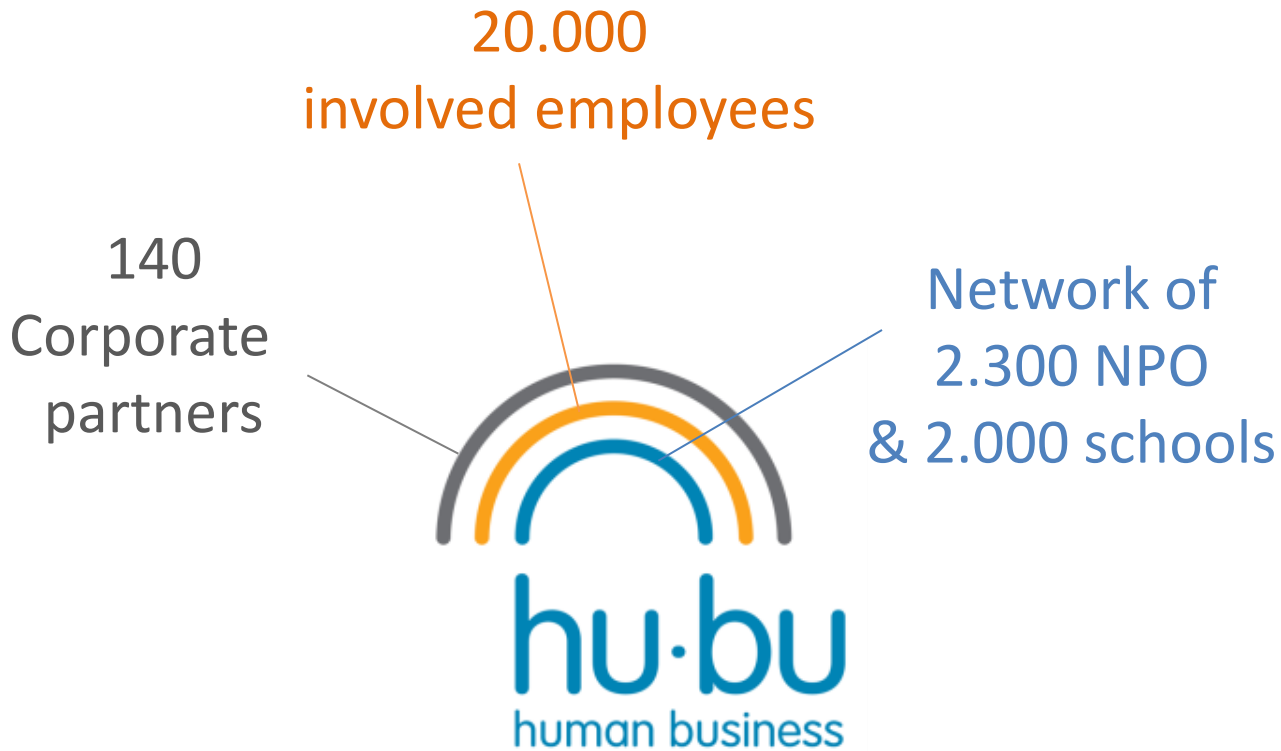
It is **good for the team work** and it is nice to meet new people and the organizations that help the community.
